Leadership & School Spirit

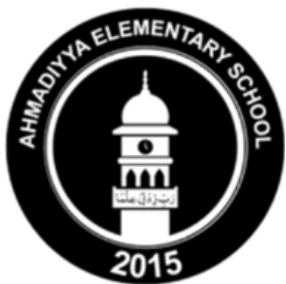
- Grades 1–4 enjoyed a wonderful trip to Downey's Farm, where they learned about animals, farming, and the importance of agriculture.

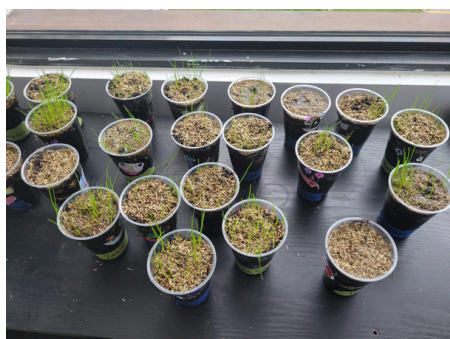

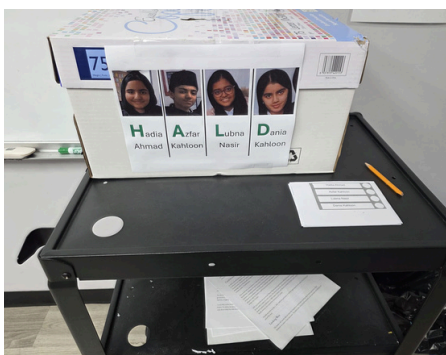
